Upon deliberation made by Dr. Anandi Subramanian, Prnl. Advisor MoEF & CC about ENVIS Hub and its mandated activities and further inclusion of Green Skill Development Programme (GSDP) & National Environment Survey (NES) launched by the MoEF & CC, Govt. of India in the meeting the learned CS agreed and asserted for Sharing all the secondary data & Maps available with different department for purpose of ENVIS Data upload and mapping in National Environment Survey (NES) and Grid Based Decision Support System (GRIDSS) in next Conference of Secretaries (CoS) meeting.

Learned CS asked PCCF (HoFF) and PCCF (Env & CC) to explore possibilities of inculcating all the 46 GSDP courses to be implemented in the State with target groups on Class 10 & 12 and other dropouts. At least 200-300 persons to be trained in district level on Arunachal Specific courses such as GSDP Bamboo Crafts, Eco-Tourism, River Cleaning and Solid Waste Management etc. If required hire master trainer from outside the State. For the purpose of meeting this noble objectives CS agreed in providing fund from the State as this was for the wellbeing and skilled empowerment of the State unemployed persons and Youths in achieving Self entrepreneurship & employment.

On Waste segregation at source and Green Skilling required in the waste management aspects the CS agreed for having such courses and also stressed for regular appointment of any suitable qualified person to discharge the duty of Member Secretary APSPCB. He/she may not belong to

the Cadre. Learned CS asked PCCF to Include Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) in the State annual budgeting Plan & its progress for providing support from the State as well.
