This is the world's first inter-continental large wild carnivore translocation project. In an endeavour to promote this initiative & underline its importance, Hon'ble PM Modi in his 'Mann Ki Baat' on September 25, 2022, asked the citizens to participate in MyGov Cheetah Contests.


