2. The State Wetland Authority may co-opt any member having expertise in the subject not exceeding three, if required.

3. The State Wetland Authority shall exercise the powers and perform the functions as per Sub-Rule 4 of Rule 5 of the Wetland (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017 which are as follows :-
 - (a) prepare a list of all wetlands of the State within three months from the date of publication of these rules ;
 - (b) prepare a list of wetlands to be notified, within six months from the date of publication of these rules ; taking into cognizance any existing list of wetland prepared/notified under other relevant State Acts ;
 - (c) recommend identified wetlands, based on their Brief Documents, for regulation under these rules ;
 - (d) prepare a comprehensive digital inventory of all wetlands within a period of one year from the date of publication of these rules and upload the same on a dedicated web portal to be developed by the Central Government for the said purpose ; the inventory to be updated every ten years ;
 - (e) develop a comprehensive list of activities to be regulated and permitted within the notified wetlands and their zone of influence ;
 - (f) recommend additions, if any, to the list of prohibited activities for specific wetlands.
 - (g) define strategies for conservation and wise use of wetlands within their jurisdiction ; wise use being a principle for managing these ecosystems which incorporates sustainable uses (such as capture fisheries at subsistence level or harvest of aquatic plants) as being compatible with conservation, if ecosystem functions (such as water storage, groundwater recharge, flood buffering) and values (such as recreation and cultural) are maintained or enhanced ;
 - (h) review integrated management plan for each of the notified wetlands (including trans-boundary wetlands in coordination with Central Government), and within these plans consider continuation and support to traditional uses of wetlands which are harmonized with ecological character ;
 - (i) in cases wherein lands within boundary of notified wetlands or wetlands complex have private tenancy rights, recommend mechanism for maintenance of ecological character through promotional activities ;
 - (j) identify mechanism for convergence of implementation of the management plan with the existing State/Union Territory level development plans and programme ;
 - (k) ensure enforcement of these rules and other relevant acts, rules and regulations and on half-yearly basis (June and December of each calendar year) inform the concerned State Government or Union Territory Administration or Central Government on the status of such notified wetlands through a reporting mechanism ;
 - (l) coordinate implementation of integrated management plans based on wise use principle through various line departments and other concerned agencies ;
 - (m) function as nodal authority for all wetlands specific authorities within the State.
 - (n) issue necessary direction for conservation and sustainable management of wetlands to the respective implementing agencies ;
 - (o) undertake measures for enhancing awareness within stakeholders and local communities on values and functions of wetlands ;
 - (p) advice on any other matter *suo-motu*, or as referred by the State Government.
4. The Authority shall constitute the technical committee and grievance committee as per Sub-Rule 6 of Rule 5 of the Wetland (Conservation and Management) Rules, 2017.
5. The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Env, & CC)/Chief Conservator of Forests (Env, & CC) shall within a period of one year from the date of publication of these rules prepare a brief document for each of the Wetland identified for notification, providing ;
 - (a) demarcation of Wetland boundary supported by accurate digital maps with coordinates and validated by ground truthing.
 - (b) demarcation of its zone of influence and land use and land cover thereof indicated in a digital map
 - (c) ecological character description
 - (d) account of pre-existing rights and privileges
 - (e) list of site specific activities to be permitted within the wetland and its zone of influence
 - (f) list of site specific activities to be regulated within the wetland and its zone of influence
 - (g) modalities for enforcement of regulation

6. The Authority based on the brief document shall make recommendations to the State Government for notifying the Wetlands.
7. The State Government shall after considering the objections, if any, from the concerned and affected persons, notify the wetlands in the Official Gazette, within a period not exceeding 240 days from the date of recommendation by the Authority.
8. The Authority shall meet at least thrice in a year.
9. The term of non-official members of the Authority, if any, nominated by the State Government shall be for a period not exceeding three years.
10. The Department of Environment and Forest shall be the Nodal Department and its Office of the Deputy Director (Environment) shall provide all necessary support and act as the Secretariat to the Authority.

No. FOR.220/IND/2005/Royalty/4391-4591.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 34(2)(h) of the Assam Forest Regulation 1891 (VII of 1891) read with the State of Arunachal Pradesh adaptation of Law order (No.2) 1988, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to prescribe rates of royalty as below on Forest Produce collected from any land/forest at the disposal of Government of Arunachal Pradesh. The revised rates of royalty shall come into effect from 08/03/2018. This supersedes earlier notification issued under Memo No.FOR.220/IND/2005/Royalty/30217-80 dtd. 30.12.2013.

2. The rates of royalty on round timber per cum. for various classes of species shall be as :

Class	Rates of royalty by enhancing 26% over the rates of 2013 on Class A I to A IV and D to F and 15% over B- C classes

Mid-girth over bark shall be measured at the middle of the log. For logs above 365 Cms in length, mid-girth however will be measured at 183 Cm from butt end. The cubic content of log will be calculated by multiplying square of quarter girth with length of log i.e $(G/4)^2 \times L = \text{Volume}$.

For debarked logs, the rates will be ten percent higher and for dressed logs, the rates will be thirty three percent higher than the above rates. Rates for sawn timber will be double the above rates for logs having mid girth over 122 Cm and above.

Royalty rates of Sand, Boulder & Shingles will remain same as per notification of the Department of Geology and Mining, Government of Arunachal Pradesh.

Wood less than one meter in length and below 60 Cm in girth (O.B) will be classed as Firewood. Wood of higher girth owing to hollowness, crookedness or any other defects unsuitable for sawing into scantlings, planks, and beam and also for peeling etc may be allowed to be removed as firewood only after splitting under supervision of the Forest Department.

All other forest produces not listed above will be charged at 12.5 percent "advalorem" of the market rate as approved/ fixed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Arunachal Pradesh for all forest areas / land irrespective of ownership of the land except in cases where specific Government order exists for removal of forest produce without realization of royalty.

Trees of Arunachal Pradesh are classified into ten classes for purpose of royalty, details of which are annexed hereto.
